

## Web Design Lessons 11-14

### Lesson 11 – Aligning an image:

1. Return to home.html in your text editor.
2. Type the code below in your document. Make sure the image

```
<p style="text-align: center">  
  
</p>
```

3. Save and view your changes. Resave to your backup homebu.txt.

### Lesson 12 – Add height and width to an image:

1. Return to home.html in your text editor.
2. Within the <img> tag for the above graphic (Lesson 11), insert the attributes width="210" height "280" as in the example below.

```
<p style="text-align: center">  
  
</p>
```

3. Save and view your changes. Resave to your backup homebu.txt.

### Lesson 13 – Create bold and italicized words:

1. Using your text editor, open home.html.
2. Type the <i> and <b> tags around key words you want to emphasis.

Example: `<p>This is an example of inserting<b>bold</b> and <i>italicized</i>text into your html document.</p>`

3. Save and view in your browser. Resave to your backup homebu.txt.

### Lesson 14 – Create a link to another website:

1. Using your text editor, open home.html.
2. Locate a word or group of words that can be linked to another site and create a link using the <a> tag as follows:

Example: `<Lisa Cruz and her guitarist,<a href="http://ededwards.com">Ed Edwards</a>, have been playing in the Denver area for the past three years.</p>`

3. Save and view in your browser. Resave to your backup homebu.txt.
