

Web Design Lessons 8-10

Lesson 8 – Add a graphic image/logo:

1. Make sure your logo file is in your website folder. The same folder your Web page document is in. Below the <body> tag insert the following code:

```
<body style="color: rgb(139,62,47); background: rgb(150,205,205);  
font-family: georgia"/>  
<p style="text-align: center"></p>  
<hr style="color: black; height: 3; clear: right"/>
```

2. Save and view your changes. Resave to your backup homebu.txt.

Lesson 9 – Add a background image:

1. Go to *www.grsites.com* and select a background image. Save it to your website folder.
2. Edit your body tag to look like the following (remove the “background rbg(##,##,##)”) and replace with background-image: url(filename.jpg):

```
<body style="color: rgb(139,62,47); background-image:  
url(filename.jpg); font-family: georgia"/>
```

3. Save and view your changes. Resave to your backup homebu.txt.

Lesson 10 – Create links between documents:

1. You begin by inserting links in the home page to your other two pages. To link to a page, you specify the name of the file using the href attribute of the <a> tag. For example, to link the phrase “Contact Me” to the contacts.html file, you enter the following HTML code:

```
<a href="contact.html">Contact Me</a> &#183;
```

Follow this example and list three links just above your horizontal line.

```
<p style="text-align: center">  
<a href="home.html">Home</a> &#183;  
<a href="about.html">AboutMe</a> &#183;  
<a href="services.html">Services</a> &#183  
</p>
```

2. Save and view your changes. Resave to your backup homebu.txt.
