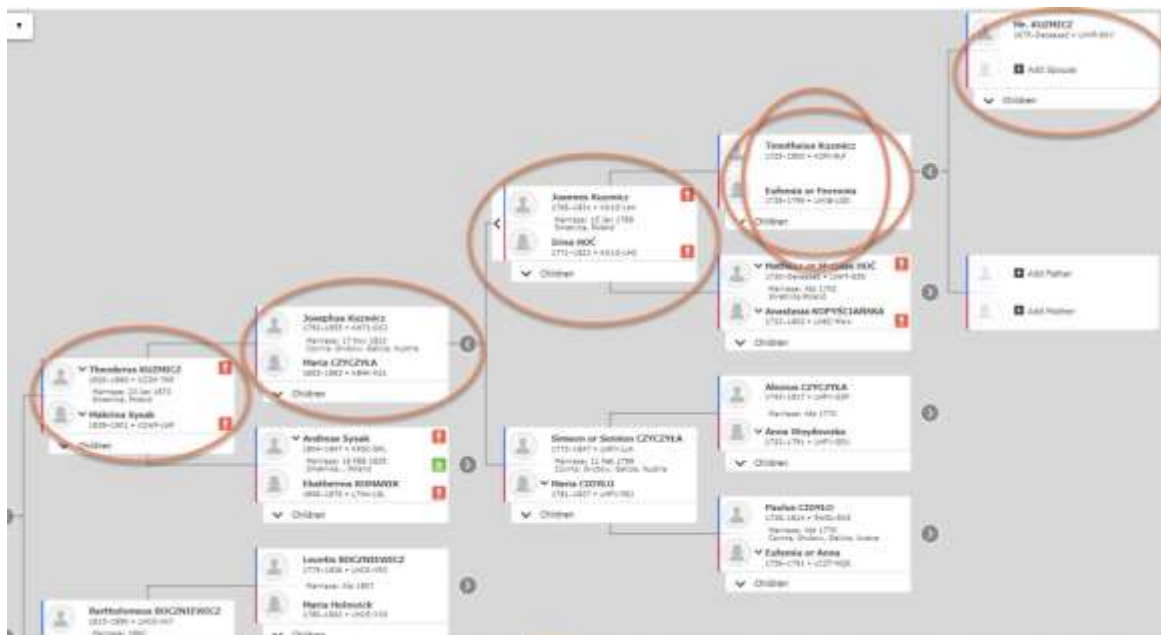


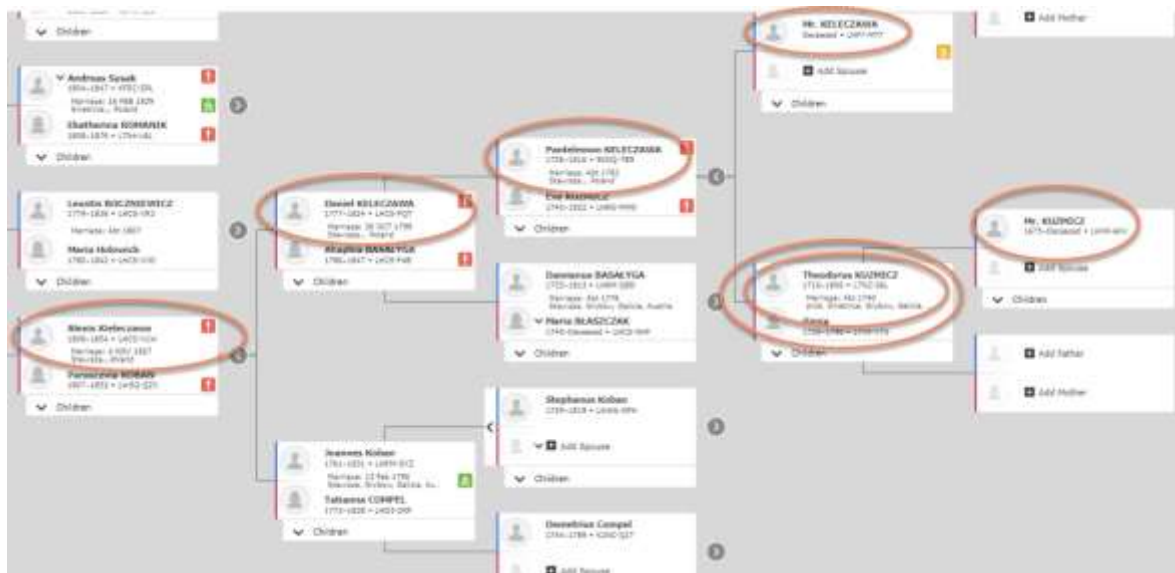
Multiple Unexpected Family History Miracles / Blessings from MyHeritage

When I created MyHeritage account and copied my Family Tree from FamilySearch.org last winter, I had no idea how important it could be. Two days ago, I received an email from MyHeritage notifying me that twelve people could be added to my account as well in FamilySearch's Family Tree if I desired with a single click of the mouse if I found this information accurate. Because MyHeritage and FamilySearch can be synchronized together whenever changes they occur, this is a unique feature available whenever changes are made on one account. Knowing this, I assigned my son to investigate these 12 people. To my surprise, these twelve people are actually linked to my great-great-great-great-grandfather born in 1675 in very rural Southern Poland. Thus, I now have two different family lines connecting to the very same oldest 1675 progenitor. See the two different screen captures below starting with Theodorus KUZMICZ and Alexis Kieleczawa which are both circled below in two screen captures.

Caution: always examine the sources to make sure they are good sources before accepting the changes to your MyHeritage account which also will be seamlessly made in your Family Tree in FamilySearch.
