**LEADING SENIORS CHOSEN BY DEANS**

With the cooperation of the Deans' Selection Committee, the HUSTLER announces today the thirty-two senior men and women who have been chosen for Vanderbilt's first representation in "Who's Who Among Students in American Colleges and Universities."

The Committee, composed of the Deans of Women, Instruction, Nursing School, Engineering School, and Medical School, with the Dean of Students as Chairman, made the selections at the request of the Student Council. Each school nominated persons according to the ratio which their total number of seniors bears to the University's Senior enrollment. No discrimination was made as to men or women, but the ratio of men and women was a guiding factor.

Each Dean submitted a list of his school's percentage of the University's total quota, and final approval of the list of nominees was given by the entire Committee. Suggested standards were leadership, individual versatility, and outstanding achievement. Overall contributions to Vanderbilt life were stressed, with character and possibility of later success playing a large part in selections.

The Student Council has submitted the selections to the National Committee. The activities of selectees pictured here have been summarized by the HUSTLER staff, with mention made only of those fields and organizations in which outstanding achievements have been made. Minor activities for the most part have been omitted.
